CLASSROOM NEWS

Room 1

For the month of June we will be working on the names of our 10 shapes. We will be working on matching them as well. We will also be working on name recognition. We will continue counting in English as well as in Spanish.

Room 2

Another exciting month is here. We will honor our dads who give us courage and strength.

We will study the human body this month. Children will learn about the human body parts, bones, muscles, digestion, and human brain.

We will focus on math jobs in Montessori time. For language art, we will review ending sound, singular and plural. We will focus on simple sentences building, and some compound words. For math, we will do addition and subtraction under 20. We will learn to read clocks too.

Room 3

Our Preschool Children will be focusing on recognizing and tracing letters H, J, U and L. We will be working on numbers from 6-9. It's the time to celebrate fatherhood. Our children will be doing activities to show the love, care and respect for their fathers.

Room 4

For Prekindergarten Group 1, our focus this month will be learning about different parts of the human body and letters A-Z upper case and lower case. We will be working on worksheets related to matching upper case letters with lower case letters. We will also be doing reading, writing and recognizing the child's name and surname. We will continue learning and recognizing numbers from 1-100.

For Group 2, children will be working on learning three letter words, practicing beginning, ending and middle phonics. For mathematics we will continue practicing addition, learning time and money. We will have craft and worksheets based on our theme for the month, Human Body and crafts and art work to honor our dads.

Some Gentle Reminders....

- We would appreciate if children who are not yet potty trained or undergoing potty training can wear buttonless pants.
- Please refrain from making your child wear light shoes.
- Please avoid any gold jewelry on your child. The school is not responsible for any lost ornaments.
- Please pick up your child's soiled clothes the same day and also replace it with extra clothes the next day. All clothing must be labeled.
- Please make sure your child's nails are trimmed at all times.

VERY IMPORTANT

- If your child has not brought his/her crib sheet and blanket, the school will provide one. Please ensure that this is brought back after washing immediately the next day. It is very challenging at our end to give reminders to get this back.

Circle time starts at 9.00a.m. and continues until 9.30a.m. This is a very important period and all what is done during this time is not repeated during the day. The children learn a lot at this time and we request that you try your best to bring your child before 9.00a.m.
